### 1550 Public Forum

It was asked when the 40 m.p.h. speed limit on the A525 through the village and 30 m.p.h. limit in Windmill Lane would be introduced. It was understood that funding has been allocated for this but no programme of future works mentions it. The Clerk was requested to get confirmation from Cllr Bailey that it will happen .

The overgrown state of the footpath along the A525 is also causing problems again. It is difficult, if not impossible for a pram/push chair to pass without going into the road, as also any invalid buggy. This to be raised with CEC Roads again.

1551/1 Neighbourhood Plan

The second questionnaire has been circulated and 48 returned. Detailed analysis of the results and comments is being undertaken, but it appears that the Council's proposed plan is well supported. A meeting with CCA to get advice for the next stage and an estimate of costs involved to be arranged ASAP.

1551/2 Defibrillator

It appears that Community Heartbeat cannot provide an enclosure opening to the right as necessary for this telephone box and are going to take back the enclosure supplied and replace with another where the defibrillator is withdrawn downwards. They are currently sorting out cost and availability of the alternative.

1551/3 Playing field railings.

Work will start on 12<sup>th</sup> October and take about a week.

1551/5 Audlem Public Hall extension

The appeal for support by APHAx was discussed and it was agreed to offer  $\pounds1000$  towards the work to be allowed for in the 2016/2017 budget.
