**1234 Minutes** The minutes of the Council meeting of 14/08/2012 were signed as correct records.

**1236 Public Forum** No points raised.

**1237 Business Matters**

**1237/1 Co-option of Councillors** It was decided to defer further discussion to the next meeting as full Council was not present.

**1237/2 Playing Field** Clerk confirmed that Buckland Tree Care have finished the maintenance work and cut back overhangs of adjacent gardens 1 metre from the boundary. Clerk to try and get a response from CEC with regard to the repair of the Cheshire railings including those recently damaged adjacent to Goodwin's corner on the A525.

**1237/3 War memorials** The new memorial should be in place by the month end. Rogers are about to lay down the foundation. It was agreed to donate £25 to ADAS towards the planting of the troughs.  
Regarding the original memorial, clerk has written to the burial board to explore the possibility of mounting it in the Chapel of Rest. Clerk to contact the PCC and make them aware of this possible alternative location.

**1237/4 Development of the playing field.** A formal, up to date quotation has been received from Wickstead. Cllr Lancaster was asked to carry the project forward, consulting as necessary on the way. An offer was gratefully accepted from Mr Joseph Bloore to make layout drawings of the complete playing field and the play equipment, together with access paths/gates etc. On completion of these drawings, clerk to solicit quotes for the extra works involved.

**1237/5 Safety on the A525** Cllr Lancaster to submit a request form to the LAP and liaise with Audlem (Cllr M Hill ) to try and get something done with regard to speeding along the A525 between Audlem and Buerton and through Buerton village.

**1237/6 Members code of conduct.** It was agreed to adopt the CEC model code of members conduct pending a Buerton council review.

**1237/7 Boundary Damage Thursfield Cottage** Council could only agree that this is a common problem to which there seems to be no practical solution.

**1237/8 Footbridge damage back lane** Clerk to contact CEC footpaths to try and get some action.
