
English Veteran Oak Trees

It is our responsibility to maintain & preserve these trees & that comes with a huge responsibility as these trees can only be maintained via planning permission & by using specialist tree surgeons.

As a parish council we need to look at ways to fund raise for their upkeep as no external funding is available. This is something the working party could help with.

Over the years recreational facilities have been added for the benefit of all & most will agree that during covid it was a great asset. The playing field has some amazing trees & grass areas, picnic benches & seating along with a range of play & gym equipment.

It is maintained to a high standard with regular tree safety inspections & tree maintenance work, regular mowing & a caretaker completing safety inspections along with other tasks to keep the area tidy & safe as possible.
