Parish Council Projects

- ➤ Litter signs have been placed in the 2 village laybys in the hope of encouraging drivers using the laybys to take their litter home.
- ➤ Buerton Parish still have a section of traditional Cheshire railings along the section of the road on entering the core of the Village. Part of the railings date back to the early 1900s and over a long period of time the railings have been repaired or replaced. They are now in a bad state of repair and are in need of attention. We are looking at funding options from various sources. This is a major project and may have to be tackled in smaller sections due to the poor state of the railings.

Community Speed Watch

During 2021 PC Jarvis trained 8 volunteers in the use of community speed watch cameras and procedures. The volunteers have so far up to December 2021 recorded 22 speeding vehicles. PC Jarvis suggested that the Parish Council might consider CSW or SID signs that could be placed on approach roads. The Parish Council agreed to look into the cost of these signs. Buerton Community Playing Field

A proposal has been made to the Parish Council for the use by a third party of a strip of land adjacent to the old school house.

There is a licence/covenant on the land and after due consideration of the proposal, it cannot find any material benefit for the Parish. Therefore, the proposal has been rejected.
